And hope for those left behind.

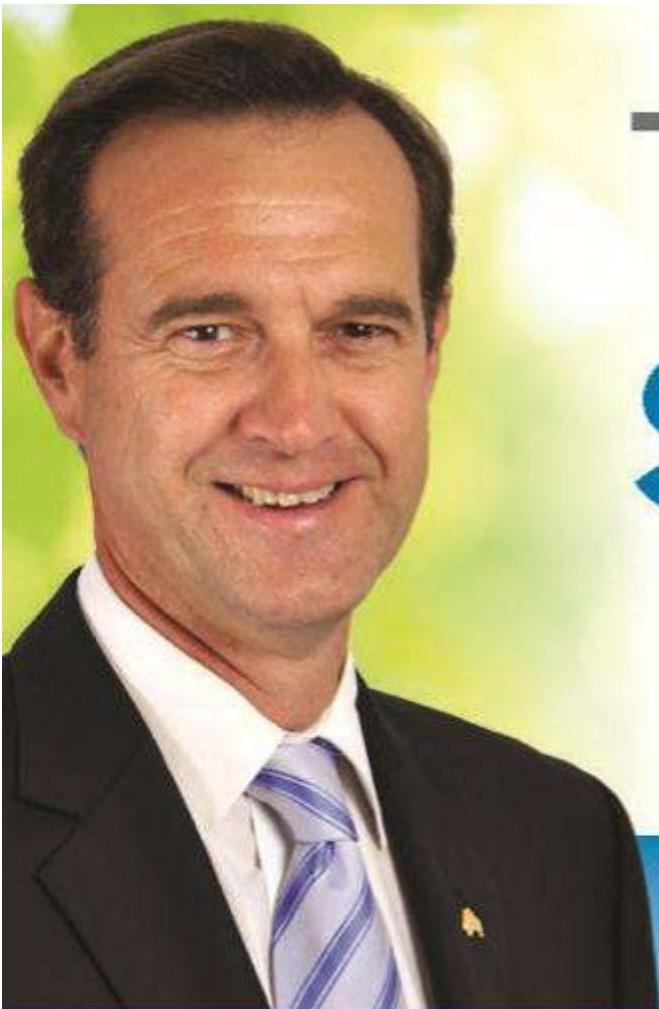
One hundred years have come and gone,

Landcare SJ is currently partnering with a range of organisations to deliver on ground natural resource management outcomes in the Shire of Serpentine Jarrahdale.

The Gooralong Brook project in partnership with the Jarrahdale Heritage Society and WA National Trust is transforming Heritage Park in Jarrahdale including weed control, revegetation and a pathway.

Continuing a 12 year partnership with the Waroona Landcare Centre, feral pests are the key target of current funding. Recent professional trapping resulted in removal of 13 foxes, two cats and numerous rabbits in the SJ area.

Protection and enhancement of threatened ecological communities is the focus of a project partnership with the Keysbrook Environmental Group, the Shire of Serpentine Jarrahdale and the Brickwood Reserve Group.

In partnership with the Darling Downs Residents Association, funding has been received for revegetation and weed control.

In total, over \$100,000 grant funding through the State NRM Office has been received to deliver these important projects.

## **SJ Equine Landcare Project**

Landcare SJ received \$20,000 from the Australian Government National Landcare Program in December. A series of events focussing on best practice land management for horse properties has been planned for the upcoming year.

## **Healthy Habitats Land Stewardship Program**

Private landholders have benefitted from the Landcare SJ/Shire of Serpentine Jarrahdale Healthy Habitats Land Stewardship project, funded through the State NRM Office. Over 80 hectares in the Shire have been protected to date, with remnant vegetation fenced, weeds controlled and revegetation planted.

## **Peel Harvey Biosecurity Group**

A new initiative commencing in 2014, the Peel Harvey Biosecurity Group, DAFWA and Landcare SJ are operating in partnership to tackle biosecurity pests in the Peel region. The Group's first AGM was held in March, with Barrie Thomson being elected Chair. The first priority is to improve cottonbush control across the Peel-Harvey region.

## **Rivers2RAMSAR project**

Connecting river corridors for landscape resilience is the goal of the Peel Harvey Catchment Council's Rivers to Ramsar project, funded through the Australian Government. Landcare SJ has been contracted to deliver outcomes along the Serpentine River and have been engaging with landowners and the Shire on fencing, weed control, riparian restoration and revegetation components of the project.

## **Lotterywest IT Grant**

Lotterywest has recently awarded \$20,000 for IT replacement at the SJ Community Landcare Centre.

## **SJ Food and Farm Alliance**

Promoting sustainable peri-urban agriculture, the SJ Food and Farm Alliance and Landcare SJ partnership continues a long tradition of agricultural landcare focus for Landcare SJ. Set aside May 16 for the family fun packed Food and Farm Fest.

## **Department of Parks and Wildlife – Banksia Woodland Grants**

Over \$47,000 was granted to landowners in the Shire of Serpentine Jarrahdale for weed and Jarrah dieback control and mapping in sensitive Banksia Woodlands on private property. The grants are being administered by Landcare SJ and include follow-up monitoring for two years.
