

2015 SJ Community Fair Textiles Exhibition

Conditions of Entry

The Serpentine Jarrahdale Community Resource Centre invites Textile entries in accordance with the following rules.

ONLY ENTRIES WHICH CONFORM TO THESE CONDITIONS WILL BE ACCEPTED.

GENERAL CONDITIONS

1. Eligibility
 - a) **General** - Entries will be accepted only from residents of Western Australia.
2. **A maximum of TWO entries may be submitted from any one Exhibitor.**
3. The greatest care will be taken with entries but The SJCRC accepts no responsibility for loss or damage. The SJCRC and anyone working or doing volunteer work for the SJCRC for the duration of the SJ Community Fair is under no obligation or liability. This includes the loss or damage occasioned to, or by, any property exhibited, whether caused by or attributed to the negligence of the SJCRC or its servant or agents or otherwise howsoever. It is recommended that the Exhibitor arrange appropriate 'all risks' insurance.
4. All entries must have been completed by the entrant.
5. The sale of Exhibits is optional. Exhibits not for sale must be marked 'NFS' on the exhibit label.
6. **No entry** which has received an acceptance in a previous SJ Community Fair competition (or which in the opinion of the Director is substantially the same as any such entry) is eligible for entry.
7. Any entry that may cause damage to any other entry or to the organiser's equipment will be rejected.
8. No refund will be made for any rejected prints.
9. The Selection Panel has full discretionary powers to make awards in all classes.
10. Permission to reproduce entries to promote the exhibition is assumed unless otherwise advised.
11. Any entry considered by the Director to be unsuitable for the exhibition will be rejected.
12. All entries must be appropriately titled for identification E.g. Untitled or Untitled #1 is NOT acceptable.

CATEGORIES

Jewellery – Beaded Jewellery, any article
Crochet – Knee Rug
Knitted Handwork – Child's or baby's garment
Knitted Handwork – Wearable Accessory – including hats, scarfs, gloves and socks
Weaving – Hand weaving, any article

SIZE REQUIREMENTS

15. All exhibits must not exceed 1.5m x 1.5m including any attachment format of framing, nor exceed 15kg in overall weight.

SALE OF ARTWORK

16. The sale of exhibits is optional. Exhibits not for sale must be marked 'NFS' on the back of the exhibit.
17. The SJ CRC encourages the sales of exhibits while the exhibition is in progress. A commission of 15% (inclusive of GST) is charged by the SJ CRC on the sale price for all exhibits sold during the exhibition. If the artist is registered for GST, the commission is levied on the sale price inclusive of GST. Payment for exhibits sold will be remitted AFTER the exhibition.

ENTRY FEES

18. **ENTRY FEES ARE \$15 PER ENTRY. CHEQUES AND MONEY ORDERS TO BE MADE PAYABLE TO:**

Suitable return post bag and postage or details of preferred courier company must be supplied. If using a courier company account details must be supplied by entrant.
19. Artists who are unable to deliver or pick up their artwork and intend to use an agent, must supply in advance a signed letter of authority which includes the name, address, signature and contact numbers of their agent.
20. **ENTRY FORMS AND FEES ONLY MUST BE RECEIVED AT THE OFFICE BY NO LATER THAN FRIDAY 17th JULY 2015.**

DELIVERY AND COLLECTION OF EXHIBITS

21. Exhibits must be delivered or received to the SJ CRC at 2 Paterson St, Mundijong WA 6123, between Monday, 27th – Friday, 31st July 2015. Office hours 9am – 5pm.
22. Exhibits can be picked up from Monday 17th August 2015 from 9am and must be collected by Friday 28th August 2015. Office hours are Mon-Fri 9am-5pm.
23. The SJ CRC will issue a receipt to the artist or their agent. This receipt must be shown at all times for the handling of the exhibit including removal from the exhibition, if not sold.
24. The SJ CRC has no facilities for long term storage and will not be responsible for any exhibits not collected within 30 days from the day of the Exhibition. Therefore the SJ CRC reserves the right to dispose of as they see fit, any exhibit not collected by the specified date.

The exhibition will be judged prior to, Thursday 13th August (exhibition closed during judging) and then on display Friday, 14th August at the Exhibition Sundowner from 5pm and during the 2015 SJ Community Fair Saturday, 15th August 10am til 4pm at the Serpentine Jarrahdale Community Resource Centre – Function Room.

COPYRIGHT AND MEDIA AGREEMENT

Copyright remains the property of the artist however, by signing the Entry Form it is agreed that artist clears Copyright to the SJ CRC, and gives permission for the SJ CRC to use images and reproduction as needed for media purposes. This will cover the two year period following the 2015 Exhibition.
